

Stop W.R.U. Collaboration with Apartheid

It is shameful that the Welsh Rugby Union has repeatedly played host to tours from the white dominated South African Rugby Board (SARB).

The supposed "multi-racial" policies of the Board are simply apartheid under another name. Multi racial sport in South Africa is a cover up which affects only a tiny minority of players.

Did you know that

The South African Rugby Board is divided along colour lines. Their clubs are either "White", "African" or "Coloured".

There is a strong non-racial rugby body, the South African Rugby Union (SARU) which on principle is not affiliated to the racially organised SARB. SARU clubs are mixed and organise 90% of all black players. Their players have been arrested and harassed for playing together.

SARU officials are denied passports to travel abroad and put their case to the world.

For most black sport players, apartheid still determines the club to which they may belong, the ground on which they may play and who they may play with or against.

Sport and Politics.

Sport in South Africa is never non racial. Mixed race teams only appear when international personalities are present or a tour is undertaken to try to undermine the boycott. This multi-racialism is a hoodwink which unfortunately some people in the WRU have fallen for.

We did not introduce politics into sport - the South African Government did through more than 100 racist laws which forbid human beings mixing freely in sport.

Colin Croft, the West Indian cricketer, learnt this when he was recently thrown out of a whites only train compartment in South Africa.

Despite widespread opposition to two recent tours from South Africa the W.R.U. has now invited Danie Craven, President of SARB as a guest and South African Springboks have been invited to play in Wales v Presidents' xv at the National Stadium on April 7th. Craven is a well known supporter of the South African Government. His changes in rugby are a bluff aimed at breaking the boycott. The boycott was called for by the oppressed people of South Africa to draw attention to their plight. To invite Craven, or his Board players is therefore a political act by the W.R.U. in support of the South African Government.

The actions of some of the officials of the W.R.U. place in jeopardy Wales' participation in other sports. They clearly seem to pay no heed to other sporting organisations. The good name of Welsh sport is being shamed by the W.R.U.



Chwaraeon a Gwleidyddiaeth

Nid nnyi ddaeth a gwleidyddiaeth i fyd chwaraeon. Llywodraeth De Affrica a wnaeth hyn drwy fwy na 100 o ddeddfau hiliol sy'n gwahardd bodau dynol rhag cymysgy'n rhudd mewn chwaraeon.

Dysgodd Colin Croft, - y cricedwr Indiaid o y Gorllewin - hyn, pan ar daith yn Ne Affrica, gafodd e ei gicio mât o gerbyd trêñ ar gyfer gwynion yn unig!

Er gwaetha'r gwrthwynebiad eang i'r ddwy daith ddiweddar o Dde Affrica, mae URC wedi gwahodd Dannie Craven, Llywydd BRDA, a rhai o'r Springboks i chwarae yng Nghymru yng ngêm Cymru v. y Llywydd yn y Stadiwm Cenedlaethol ar 7ed Ebrill. Mae Craven yn gefnogwr mawr o lywodraeth De Affrica. Twyll yw ei newidiadau yn rygbi i geisio torri'r boicot. Galwodd pobl ormesedig De Affrica am y boicot er mwyn tynnu sylw at eu sefyllfa drychinebus. Felly, mae penderfyniad URC i wahodd Craven a'i chwaraewyr o BRDA yn weithrediad gwleidyddol gan URC sy'n dangos ei gefnogaeth am lywodraeth De Affrica.

Mae gweithredoedd rhai o swyddogion URC yn peryglu cyfle Cymru i chwarae mabolgampau eraill. Dydyn nhw ddim yn malio dim am fudiadau chwaraeon eraill. Du yw enw da chwaraeon Cymru oherwydd gweithredoedd cywilyddus Undeb Rygbi Cymru.
