

The emergence of massive trade union organisations in South Africa and Namibia have added new and dynamic forces to the struggles for freedom and democracy in these countries.

Inevitably the trade union federations COSATU in South Africa and NUNW in Namibia have been at the forefront of the mass campaigns against apartheid and minority rule.

Inevitably, too, these organisations have faced the harassment and persecution of the apartheid regime.

In both South Africa and Namibia trade unionists have been detained, intimidated and attacked. Union offices have been ransacked and journals have been banned.

Last year the headquarters of COSATU were destroyed by a massive bomb explosion, striking railway workers were shot dead in the street and other union activists were kidnapped and murdered by the regime's vigilantes and terror squads.

The leaders of the NUNW were among those detained in a round up of leading opponents of South Africa's occupation of Namibia. They were released following international protests.

This conference aims to identify the most pressing needs of the trade union and democratic struggles in Southern Africa; and it will discuss how best the different sections of the trade union movement in Scotland can respond.

It is a delegate conference for trade union branches and committees, trades councils and shop stewards committees. There is a registration fee of £5.00 per delegate.
