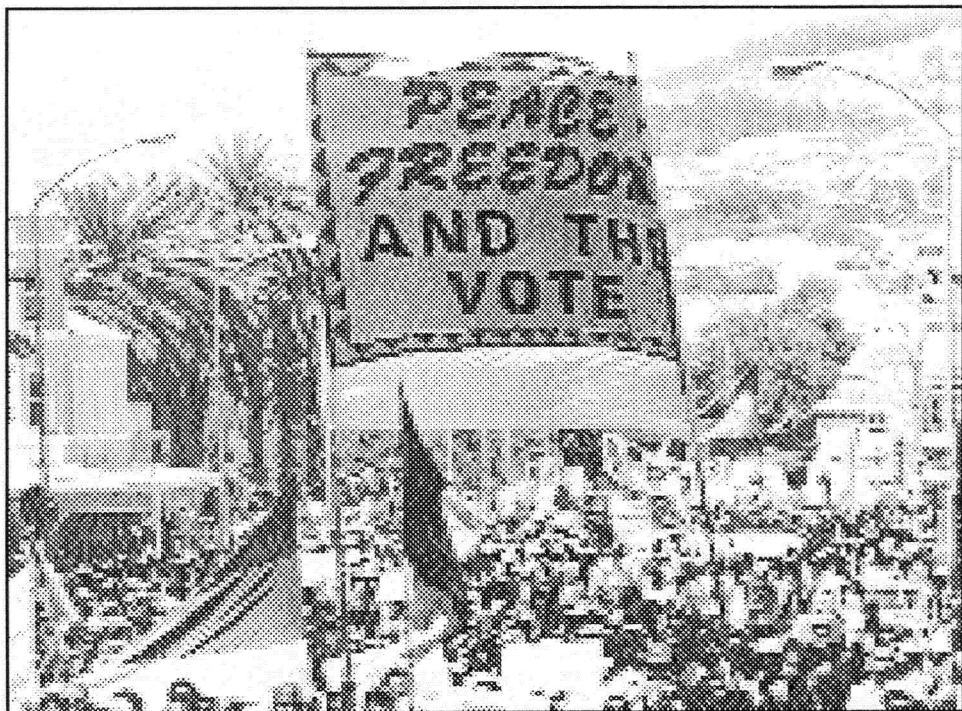


Peace, freedom and the vote

Millions of Black South Africans are on the march. They are demanding peace now! They are demanding freedom now! And above all they are demanding the vote now! This is their response to the assassin's bullet which took the life of Chris Hani, one of the most popular leaders of the freedom struggle in South Africa, on 10 April.

The people who took to the streets immediately following his murder were demonstrating their anger at this cruel and vicious act. But these mass protests were also an expression of their impatience at the lack of any tangible progress towards the 'new' South Africa of which there has been so much talk, since the release of Nelson Mandela over three years ago.

The African National Congress and other democratic forces are insisting that there must be agreement immediately on:

- the date for South Africa's first ever one-person one-vote elections;
- joint control of the security forces;
- multi-party transitional arrangements in order to ensure that the elections are genuinely free and fair.

Through mass action, the ANC and its allies are demanding change now. We need to demonstrate our solidarity. Effective international pressure needs to be applied now on the De Klerk regime and all others resisting democratic change.

Above all we need to compel the British government to act. It should be giving its support to the ANC at this critical stage in South Africa's history. But instead, John Major and other British Ministers appear to be more concerned with accommodating their 'friends' like FW de Klerk and Chief Buthelezi – the very people who are blocking progress towards a new democratic future for South Africa.
