Dear Dr. Owen,

I am writing to draw to your attention information regarding two breaches of the arms embargo on South Africa.

First, I enclose a publication of the Anti-Apartheid Movement entitled Computerising Apartheid, which provides information on the supply of ICL computers to the South African police and arms industry.

Secondly, I enclose a transcript of a programme transmitted by BBC Television on 6th November, entitled Arming Apartheid. The transcript reveals detailed information on the supply of arms to South Africa.

The Anti-Apartheid Movement urges the Government to take all necessary measures to prevent further breaches of the embargo and believes that a full Parliamentary inquiry should be established to investigate the operation of the embargo.
