

CONFERENCE ON SOUTHERN AFRICA

Friday 7th July to Sunday 9th July, 1972

The NUS is organizing a weekend conference, as part of the joint NUS/Anti Apartheid Movement Southern Africa Campaign, at Plaw Hatch Trade Union Country Club, East Grinstead, Sussex.

The purpose of the conference, which will be attended and addressed by representatives of liberation movements, is for current members of the network to analyse and discuss the past year's activities together with people now joining the network, and also with area and local union representatives.

We need to look in detail at what has been done this year, and to map out a strategy for developing the campaign in good time for the 1972-73 session, as well as to create some basis for continuing action over the long vacation, particularly in relation to what may happen over Zimbabwe. We also need to discuss the production of resource material, etc.

There is a registration fee of £8.00, to cover food and accommodation (Friday evening to midday Sunday) but area officials and unions have been asked to help network members wishing to attend.

Please use this opportunity to develop our campaign by attending, and it would be valuable if you could try to ensure that your area has an informed member of the network involved in its activities next session by bringing along such a person who would be active next year.
