SOLIDARITY ACTION NEEDED - QUICKLY!

In SOUTH AFRICA more than 30 people have been arrested in recent weeks and are being detained without trial or access to lawyers or relatives under the notorious Terrorism Act. Among those detained are Mrs Winnie Mandela, wife of Nelson Mandela, and Philip Golding, a British subject. Write now to the South African Ambassador (SA House, Trafalgar Square WC2) demanding their release; write also to the Foreign Secretary (Foreign Office, Downing Street SW1), urging that the strongest representations be made to Vorster's regime to secure Golding's release. Detainees are subjected to solitary confinement and often cruelly tortured. HMG must not be allowed to remain passive. Let principles and humanity take precedence over profits and expediency - for once!

In LESOTHO South African refugee Joe Molefi has lost his appeal against a deportation order, and has requested leave to appeal to the Privy Council. His was a test case - the future of some 70 other refugees is now at stake. If Chief Leabua Jonathan's Government deports them back to South Africa, they face imprisonment. Write now to the High Commissioner for Lesotho (16A - 1st floor, St James's Street SW1) urging no deportations to the Republic of South Africa.

(Lesotho, surrounded by the Republic, is economically dependent on its apartheid neighbour. Even allowing for this, the Jonathan Government has surprised many observers by its readiness to collaborate with Vorster's regime. Its Chief Justice, Attorney General, four of its Magistrates, the Chief Electoral Officer, and many other Government officials, are white South Africans, most of them still paid by Pretoria. What price independence?)
