"EMPIRE" - South African goods may not be sold under the "Empire" label after 31st October 1963 - and special offers are being made in grocers and supermarkets, etc. to clear stocks marked "Empire". Some importers may be using the "Foreign" label to avoid labelling produce "South African". Goods exported from Australia, Canada and New Zealand, for example, are required by their own laws to be clearly marked with the country of origin.

CANNED FRUIT SOLD UNDER SOME LABELS e.g. LIBBY, I.X.L., BENEDICT, CIVIS,  
IS IMPORTED FROM ALL OVER THE WORLD - SO ALWAYS CHECK THE LABEL.

Fresh fruit imported from S. Africa includes oranges, apples, grapes, pears and lemons; also imported are vegetables such as onions. In addition, other more 'exotic' fruits - avocado pears, guavas, pineapples, litchis (or lychees), melons, apricots, peaches, mangoes, pawpaw and several varieties of red and yellow plums.
